This census is an exclusive and a valuable asset to our family history, as it describes in detail the particulars of the first Sasieni family members to have officially immigrated to America and would not return to their country of origin, England.

Note the spelling of the surnames. This was probably due to administrative errors by the immigration officers or the census information gatherers. Later the descendants of our immigrant ancestors to the United States, would be known by the surnames of Sasiene and Sasine.
